How to Create a Magnifying Glass

Getting Started

1. Open ACTIVstudio 2 and select the flipchart button to open a new flipchart.
2. Open the resource library and select Shared Shapes.
3. Drag the black solid circle to the flipchart and enlarge.
4. Right click on the circle, select edit>layer>top.
5. Right click on the pen to open the pen modifier toolbox.
6. Change the width of the pen by dragging the slider to 12.
7. Select the circle tool and draw a circle on the flipchart.
8. Select the marquee selector tool (arrow) and double click the circle to open the object edit menu.



9. Select Duplicate to create another circle. Drag that circle off to the side.
10. Move the first outlined circle shape on top of the solid colored circle.
11. Using the eraser tool, carefully erase the inside of the solid colored circle.
12. Right click the second outlined circle>select edit>bring to front.
13. Drag it on top of the other outlined circle.
14. You should not see any of the solid circle.
15. Draw a handle on the circles to complete the magnifying glass.
16. Lasso the circles and handle to select all.
17. Double click and select properties in the object edit toolbar.
18. Select Identification and place a check in the grouped.
19. Name and save your flipchart.



Drag your magnifying glass to your toolbar for future use.
