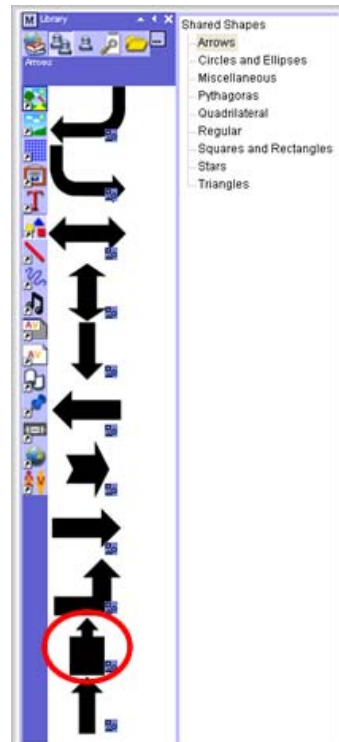
Using Arrows to Create a Self-Checking Flipchart

Open ACTIVstudio 2

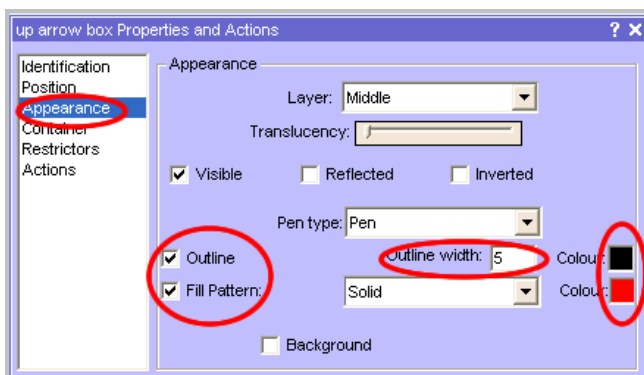
Create a worksheet that requires students responses. These can be written, dragged or even spoken. Create a self-checking object using arrows located in the Shared Shapes folder.

Create the Arrow Answer Box

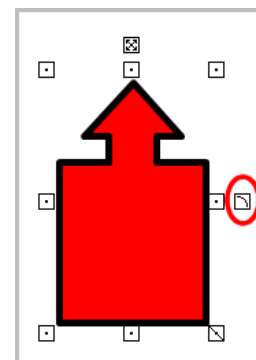
1. Open the Resource Library and select the Shared Shapes button.
2. Expand the window so that the resource tree is viewable and select the top folder which is **Arrows**.
3. A great choice to use is called the **up arrow box** as shown in the diagram to the right.
4. Drag it to the flipchart and expand to make it large enough to contain the answers needed for that flipchart.
5. Format the arrow by double clicking the arrow.
6. Select object properties as shown below.



7. Select **Appearance** and change the fill color and outline color to match your flipchart.
8. Change the outline width to 5 to make your arrow more pronounced.



9. You can turn the arrow in any direction using the object rotate feature as shown in the diagram.

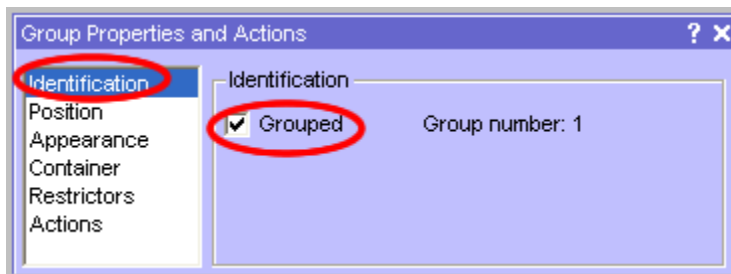


Adding Images or Text to the Answer Box and Grouping

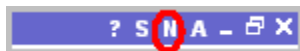
1. Insert an image in the answer box or type the answers using the **Text Tool**.
2. Once the image or text is centered and aligned correctly, everything needs to be grouped.
3. Lasso the arrow and answers by drawing a box around everything.
4. It will appear that only the arrow is selected.
5. Double click on the arrow to launch the object edit box and select the red check.



6. This time select **Identification** and check the **Grouped** box. The arrow and answers will now be one object that can be moved. (If they are not grouped, all objects were not selected. Try to lasso again and repeat the steps).



7. Move the arrow off the flipchart so that only the head of the arrow shows.
8. Always provide directions in flipchart notes so that the chart user will know that the self-checking arrow exists.



9. Save your flipchart.
