



Dreamweaver: Editing Images in Fireworks

You can edit graphics from within Dreamweaver regardless if they were created in Fireworks or other image editing application. You can launch Fireworks within Dreamweaver to edit and add additional features.

Editing Within Dreamweaver

1. Select the image so that is bounded by handlebars.
2. In the Image Property Inspector several editing features are listed.

Actions

Launches Fireworks on top of Dreamweaver and allows you to edit within Fireworks.

Optimize an image for quality and output.

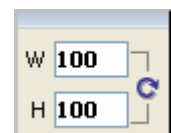
Crops an image directly on the web page.

Resample image.

Adjusts brightness and contrast of an image.

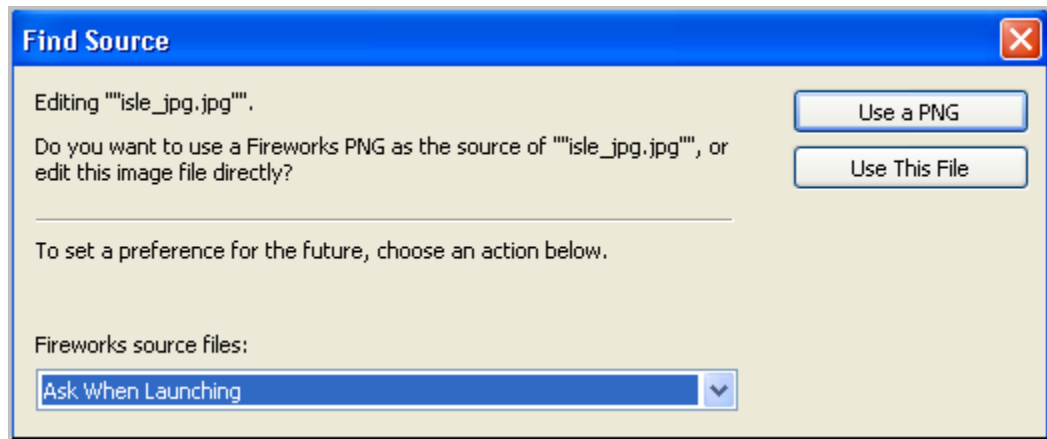
Sharpens an image.

3. When editing within the web page use the undo and redo buttons on the standard toolbar if changes aren't desirable.
4. You can resize an image in the Property Inspector by changing the width and height of the image and pressing enter. To change it back to its original size select the **Resample** button to the right of the image size and it will return to its original size.

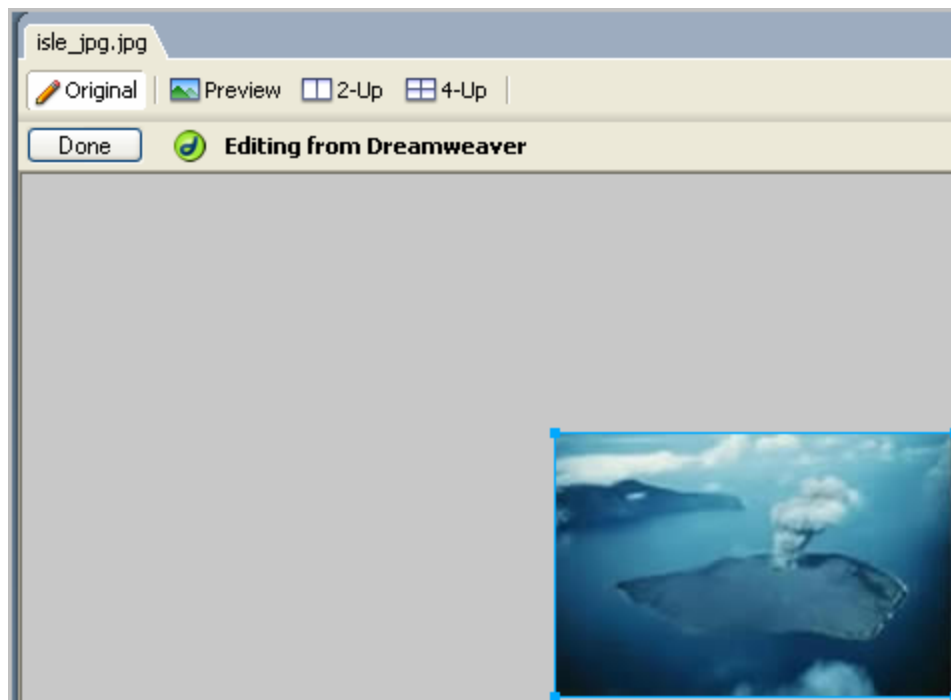


Editing Within Fireworks

1. When Fireworks is launched a confirmation window opens requesting which file to use for editing. Unless there is a .png file available, the source file will be used.



2. Once the image is edited, select **Done** button at the top left and the image will automatically be updated in Dreamweaver.



3. Some editing features that add to your images:
 - **Creative Feature** – On the menu select Command > Creative to add a frame, change to grayscale, fade an image as well as change sepia tones.
 - Add **Effects** using the Property Inspector such as shadows and bevels.
 - Use **Text** tool to add text on an image.
 - Use **Vector** or **Bitmap** tools to label or draw on an image.
 - **Skew** tools can be an option to change images orientations.
 - **Be Creative!**
