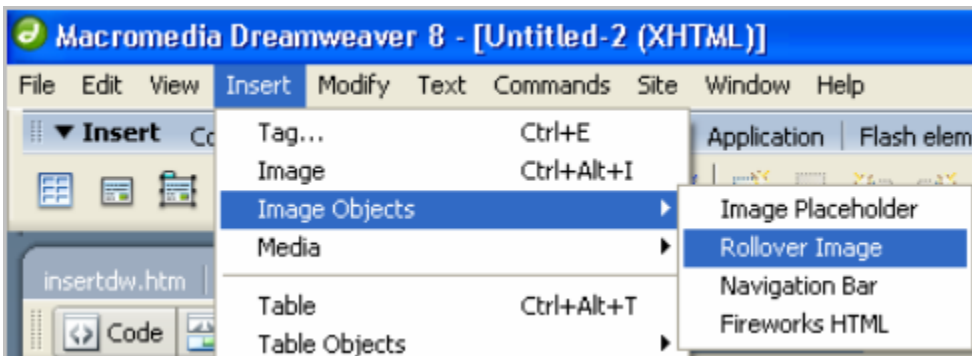




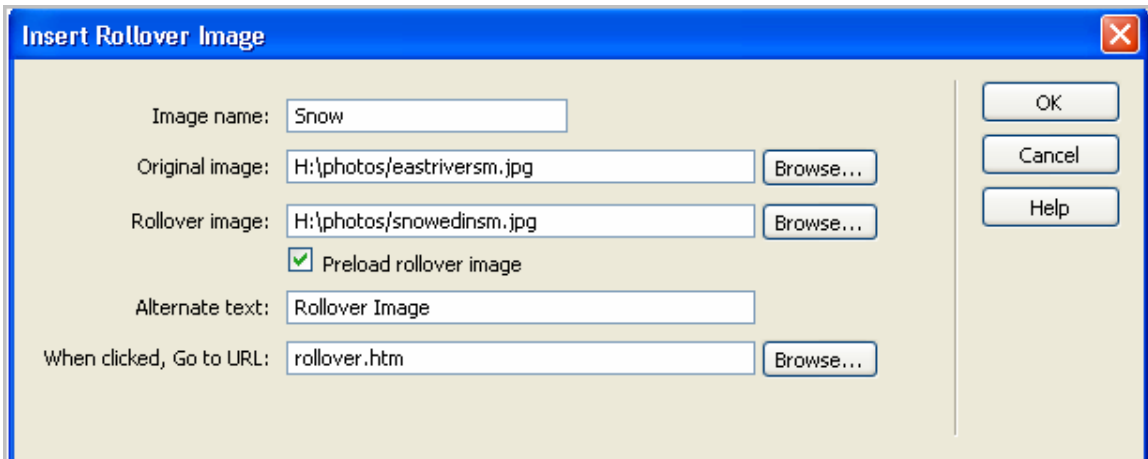
Dreamweaver: Inserting Rollover Images

Photos, graphics and even text work well with this feature. Fireworks is a great application to format these images. Two same size photos are used for this task.

1. Insert cursor on the Dreamweaver page for the location of the rollover.
2. Go to Insert on the menu bar and select Image Objects>Rollover Image.



3. Enter a name for the image.
4. Select the first browse button and locate the original image.
5. Select the second browse button to locate the rollover image. This is what the viewer will see when the mouse rolls over the image.
6. Check Preload rollover image.
7. Add alternate text and URL if the image will be a link. Click OK.



Note: If you don't set a link for the image, Dreamweaver inserts a null link (#) in the HTML source code to which the rollover behavior is attached. If you remove the null link, the rollover image will no longer work.
