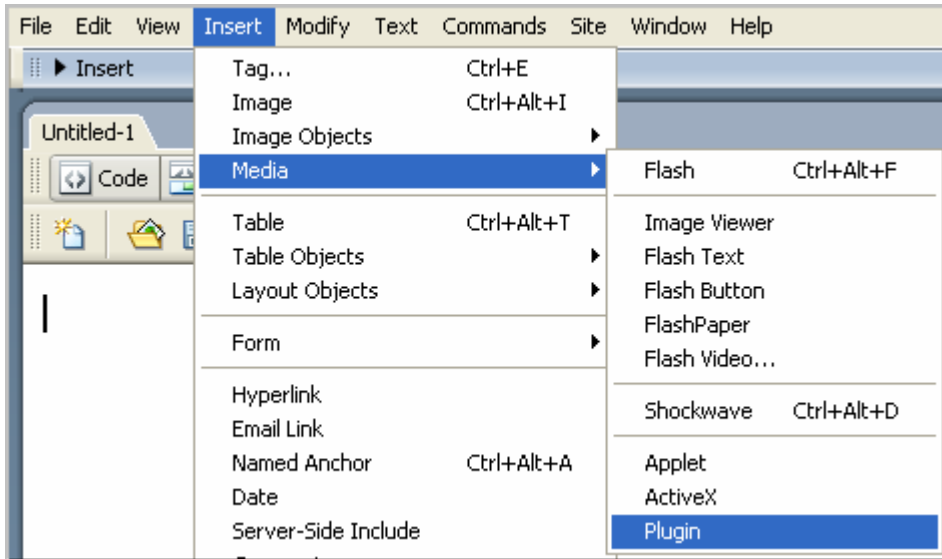




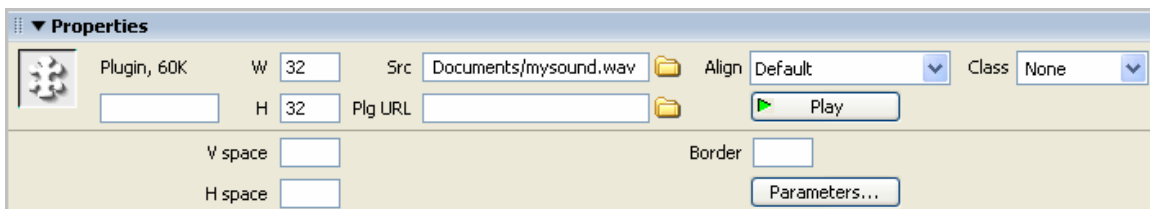
## Dreamweaver: Inserting Sound

The most common sound formats used in the Internet are MP3, WAV and MIDI, although there are many different formats that can be used as well.

1. Insert cursor on the Dreamweaver page for the location of the audio file.
2. Go to Insert on the menu bar and select **Media > Plugin**.



3. Locate the file and insert.
4. The sound file will appear in Dreamweaver as shown.
5. When selected the properties of the audio file will be displayed in the property inspector panel.



6. The controls will show on the page with its default size. If you want to hear the sound but not see the audio controls, change the fields' value for W and H to 0 in the properties panel.
7. Sound automatically starts when a page is launched and the only way to edit the embedded sound is through code.
8. Be sure the sound file is uploaded along with the web page.

**Note: Remember audio files are large files and length of file should be considered. Web viewers are also distracted by sound and may be unwanted by viewers.**
