

# Dreamweaver: Web Photo Album

**If you have a group of pictures you want to put up on the web quickly, this nifty feature is just for you. Dreamweaver will process a group of images and index them as thumbnails as well as put each full sized image on it's own page with navigation.**

**NOTE:** You will need to have Fireworks installed to create the Web Photo Album.

## Housekeeping: Image File

1. Create a folder to store your images(.jpeg. or .gif)
2. Name the folder according to the theme of your images.
3. Copy images to that folder. This will be the source folder.

## Step 1: Getting Started and Setting Up the New Site

1. Right click on the root folder in the files panel. If you do not see your files panel select Window on the menu bar and check Files or press F8.
2. Select New Folder and type your site name using one word.

## Step 2: Create the Web Photo Album

1. Begin a new html page. Select File> New > Create.
2. Go up to **Commands>Create Web Photo Album...**
3. Enter **Album Title** Info, which will be **site name**. This will go at the top of the web page but may be changed later with a graphic or image. You must have a title to create the album.



4. Enter Subheading and Other Info if desired. These will be under the Title. Subheadings are optional.
5. Click the **Browse...** button to navigate to your source images .
6. Click **Browse...** to choose the destination folder.
7. Choose a **Thumbnail** Size by clicking the drop down menu. Remember 72 pixels equal an inch.
8. You can choose to have the file name of each image displayed by selecting the "**Show Filenames**" option.
9. Columns are the number of columns for the thumbnails. Choose number dependent on the size of the thumbnails chosen for this page.
10. Choose a format for **thumbnails**. This is how your image will appear on the main page.
11. Select a format for your photo format. This will be the appearance of you photo on a linked page. If your images have not been compressed then you would want to scale your images. Do so by inputting a percentage value in the Scale Field.
12. If you want a navigation bar for each page (text based) select the last option
13. Click **OK** to create the album.



### Step 3: Processing the images

Fireworks will open and begin processing both the thumbnails and the images. When it's completed, you'll get a dialog window telling you the album was created.

**If your images are not aligned select the columns to highlight all images and select No Wrap in the properties inspector box.**
