Directors Report – John Mashburn – Thank you for being  
here and Happy New Year. A couple of things – we need to  
register for our competitions next year. The cost for October  
9<sup>th</sup> Bands of America at Jacksonville State University (JSU)  
is \$650 and the Band of America on October 29 at the  
Georgia Dome is \$800 for a total of \$1450. It was moved by  
Maureen Nelson, Seconded by Robin Vale and voted on –  
passed.

Karen and Bill Allem – Fundraising

Bill proposed a Spring festival – a multi-event if you will, with  
walking in the spring, garage sales, health fair, car washes,  
etc. Tom Jablonski, Jim Morrow and Bill will meet and make  
plans starting next week. There will be sign up sheets in the  
front at the next meeting for anyone who wants to help.

Karen and Beth Harren – Verizon Ampitheater – working a concession stand? Beth has checked into the possibility of us getting a concession or beverage stand and we work at multiple events and earn a percentage of the sales. This would involve adults only and be an 8 month commitment. There are approximately 26 events over the course of the season. We would need 6 – 10 people per event. We could bring in a potential of \$5000 for the season. We need a team leader to arrange coverage of the events. Beth will handle this. Volunteers will be trained and need to wear black pants – Verizon provides the shirts to wear.

They explored the option of working a Falcons Game – potential is \$1200 per game with 10 parents working. It is thought that our marching season would be a major conflict in getting volunteers for this.

Flower bulbs will be on sale in the next week or so and will be delivered in March.

Little Caesars pizza will be after the bulbs and information will be gathered on that.

Bill Allem – Chris Cleaners – Community Outreach – 10 people go, 10% per quarter. (Located at the corner of 306 and 369).

Sonny Lennard – Golf Tournament – Scheduled for March 29<sup>th</sup> (Monday) at the Hampton Club. We are getting charged \$28 per head and we will charge \$60. Our goal is to have 100 players. More information will be forthcoming.

Treasurer – Robin Vale

There is \$16,114.52 in the savings account, \$18,799.58 in the checking account. All bills have been paid and there are \$10,130.15 in outstanding Fall Fees. The winter fees have been billed so there is a total of \$33,236.79 total in accounts receivable. We are looking into a collection agency to possibly handle the delinquencies – last year there were only \$5K late at this point.

SMI – is scheduled for March 21 – 22. Committee Meetings will be scheduled in the near future.

Beth Harren has agreed to work on some regularly scheduled car washes thru the summer – stay tuned.
