

FORSYTH CENTRAL BAND BOOSTERS MEETING

October 9, 2006

Rudi Hulsey called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

A motion was made and carried for the September Band Booster Meeting minutes to be accepted. These are available on the website.

Treasurer's Report: The financial report will be deferred until next month due to illness.

Trailer Update: Rudi Hulsey - The newly acquired trailer is presently parked behind the visitor's stands. Construction is well under way on the interior remodeling. Workers are needed, as are tools to complete this job in time for the BOA competition. Some of the tools that would be helpful are: charged cordless drills, cordless screwdrivers, circular saw, etc. The next work session will be on Saturday at 10:00.

Division 5 comp ticket update: Mr. Hampton was able to get 15 more comp tickets per home game. This brings our total to 45 tickets. If you are able to be in the stadium before 5:00, there is no need for a ticket. However, at 5:00 or after, meet Rudi at the far gate for your comp ticket. After these tickets are gone, you will need to buy your ticket. At all AWAY games, our number of tickets remains at 30.

Spirit Wear: Jeri Ewing – We still need volunteers to staff the Spirit Wear table at the home games. Please contact Jeri to sign up.

50/50 Raffle: Rudi Hulsey- We need volunteers willing to work the Visitor's stands – 4 per game. Contact Randy Suggs.

Cookie Dough Fund Raiser: This fundraiser has been completed. The \$100 winner will be announced at band practice this Thursday. Net profits will be announced at the Nov. meeting. The cookie dough will be here in approx. two weeks. Volunteers are needed to help sort the orders.

\$5000 Raffle: Rudi Hulsey – We will be selling \$20 raffle tickets again this year. The winner will be announced at the last home game. (Nov. 3) The winner does not have to be present to win. The contact information will be written on each sold ticket. Ideally, each child would sell a book of 5 tickets. This would be a net profit of \$15,000 for the band.

Chaperones: Cathy McKinnon – Thanks to all of the chaperones this fall. If you are signed up to chaperone the BOA trip, please do not assume that you will get a free ticket. Cathy will be contacting those (regular band parent chaperones) that will be receiving these.

Director's Report: Mr. Mashburn - The kids have worked very hard and they did very well at the Eagle's Nest competition. I am extremely proud. 95.85 was the final score for the band.

There will be 43 bands competing in the BOA. This will take place over two days. We are competing in the afternoon on Saturday. We do not have a large block of tickets set aside. Everyone is responsible for their own tickets. They can be ordered at bands.org.

We will not be performing the show at Homecoming.

We welcome Jerry Tucker. He has volunteered to drive our new trailer.

Vice President: Daniel Arocho - Our spirit table booth is ready to be moved and anchored into place. I need a few volunteers to help with this.

Color Guard Report: Sue Mashburn - We will be hosting a two-day Winter Guard competition on March 10 & 11. This will require an enormous effort by volunteers similar to that of GBC.
