Fruit Sales – The order forms for Indian River fruit sales will be sent home around the 1st of October with delivery around the 1st of December. There is a need for volunteers to help with the unloading when the shipment arrives at school.

Coupon Cards - After the holidays, we can sell \$10 coupon cards with local vendors. A vote was taken on this and half were for and half were against.
